



SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR THE GOVERNOR'S LEADERSHIP FOUNDATION (GLF) PROGRAM

A number of full or part scholarships or awards are available to people who will, by their participation in the Governor's Leadership Foundation Program, add important diversity of background and experience to the program group but who do not have the means to pay the full program fee. Such scholarships are normally reserved for those working in small community organisations, unpaid roles, small business, self-employed, or who are living a long way from Adelaide (and therefore require support for travel expenses). We do not ordinarily consider applications for scholarships from those in full-time paid employment in business or government roles based in the Adelaide metropolitan area except in extraordinary circumstances. Applications for the following scholarships should be made via the scholarship application form available on our website at www.leadersinstitute.com.au and submitted along with your completed application for the GLF program.

THE PASTOR SIR DOUG NICHOLLS AND LADY GLADYS NICHOLLS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is being funded by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet. It was set up to commemorate the 10th anniversary of the Governor's Leadership Foundation in 2010 in order to help encourage and facilitate the participation of Aboriginal leaders in the GLF program. The scholarship has been established in the name of the first (and only) Aboriginal Governor of South Australia, Pastor Sir Douglas Nicholls and his wife Lady Gladys Nicholls in recognition of their significant leadership in such a broad diversity of areas (sports, social justice, human rights, governance).

DFEEST ABORIGINAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Department of Further Education, Employment, Science and Technology (DFEEST) reflects and supports the Government of South Australia's priorities of sustaining a vibrant economy and socially inclusive community by developing the state's workforce, skills base and lifelong learning opportunities. It supports a full scholarship in the GLF program for an Aboriginal participant.

LEADERS INSTITUTE ABORIGINAL AWARD

This is an award for an Aboriginal participant in the Governor's Leadership Foundation Program that covers $\frac{3}{4}$ of the program fee. The funding for this award has been generously provided by Terry Teo, a graduate of the GLF program in 2005, and his wife April Muirden. Terry and April are committed to helping address the social, economic, health, housing and educational disadvantages experienced by our Aboriginal population, and to helping facilitate Aboriginal people's full participation in the community and the life of the state.

COMMUNITY BUSINESS BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

The Community Business Bureau (CBB) is a not-for-profit organisation with a mission to provide services and programs which build the capacity and capability of not-for-profit organisations. CBB is proud to once again show its commitment to leadership development in the community sector by offering this full scholarship for the

Governor's Leadership Foundation to a community sector employee.

ADELAIDE AIRPORT LTD REGIONAL LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP

Adelaide Airport Ltd (AAL) believes participating in community activities fosters the state's reputation as a vibrant and world-class location in which to live. It has been a major supporter of the GLF program for the last three years. In an effort to help the Leaders Institute strengthen and build its participant and alumni base beyond Adelaide, AAL is offering a full scholarship for the 2012 GLF program for a leader based in a regional SA community.

GLF ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

The alumni of the GLF funds one full or two partial scholarships each year. The scholarships are generally reserved for those working in community organisations, part-time or unpaid roles, small business, self-employed or who are living a long way from Adelaide.
